Directions: Today we celebrate Palm Sunday and we remember when Jesus was welcomed into the city of Jerusalem. Crowds had gathered in anticipation of the Passover and as Jesus entered the city, they welcomed him by throwing down their garments and palm branches before him shouting, "Hosanna to the Son of David!" "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!" Today we also hear the passion of our Lord and how Jesus was handed over to Pontius Pilate to be crucified. Jesus was beaten, spat upon, and made to carry a heavy wooden cross to the place that he would be crucified. There was a man, Simon of Cyrene, who was made to help Jesus carry his cross. This week, think about people you know who might be carrying a heavy cross (or who might be suffering in some way). What can you and your family do to help others?
