CLOW Gospel Overview

Today we celebrate the Nineteenth Sunday of Ordinary Time. For the past three weekends, the Gospel has been part of the [Bread of Life Discourse](#). In the Gospel passage for this weekend, from John 6: 41-51, the Jewish authorities struggle to believe who Jesus says he is. Jesus says that he is the bread of life; however, the people around him question this because Jesus is just an ordinary guy (so they think). But we know who Jesus is. Jesus is the Son of God – he *is* the bread of life and he is more than just an ordinary guy! Even so, it can be easy for us too to take for granted who Jesus is and how he is truly present to us in the Eucharist. This week, take some time to learn more about the Eucharist.
