Today we celebrate the First Sunday of Advent. In today's Gospel, we hear the Jesus tell his disciples that he would come again. He tells them that he will come in a cloud with great power and glory. Jesus tells his disciples that they need to be ready for when he comes again – even though they do not know when Jesus will come again. Waiting is not always easy, especially when we do not know when something will happen.
