## CLOW Gospel Reflection

**Reflection:** Today we celebrate the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time. In the Gospel, we hear that Jesus returned to the place where he grew up, Nazareth, and that while in Nazareth, he went to the Synagogue. Jesus was reading a passage from scripture, which explained who he was and what he was sent to do: to bring glad tidings (good news) to the poor. *What do you think the "good news" is that Jesus brought?* The good news that Jesus brought was the message of God's love for us all. This good news is something that we are all called to bring to one another – the message of God's love. *This week, how will you and your family bring the good news of God's love to others?*
