CLOW Gospel Reflection

Reflection: Today we celebrate the Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time. Today's Gospel story is a continuation from the Gospel story we heard last weekend. In the Gospel today, Jesus is preaching to the people in his own hometown, Nazareth. Many people in Nazareth knew Jesus since he was a young boy. When he was preaching, the crowd even recognized that Jesus was the son of the Carpenter (Joseph). But it was hard for the crowd to hear what Jesus was saying about himself – that he was the Son of God. Like the crowds, sometimes it is hard for us to see the special qualities of those we know well. We see those that we know well as “ordinary.” But we are all extraordinary and we all have something special to share with each other. *What special or unique gift do you have to share with others?*
