CLOW Gospel Reflection

Reflection: Today we celebrate the Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel we hear how many people had come to see and hear Jesus preach. So that Jesus could be heard, he asked Simon Peter to sail a little way from the shore. After Jesus was done preaching, he told Simon Peter to sail out into the deep waters and to cast out his net. Simon Peter however, had been out fishing all night, and couldn't imagine they could catch anything. Simone Peter though agreed, and cast his net out just as Jesus told him. To his surprise, he caught so many fish that his net began to break. Simon Peter and his friends knew they saw something extraordinary – so they left their nets and followed Jesus. Just as Jesus' first disciples were called to trust him, we too are called to trust Jesus and to follow him.
