Watch our **Children's Liturgy of the Word** video and listen carefully to the readings for today.

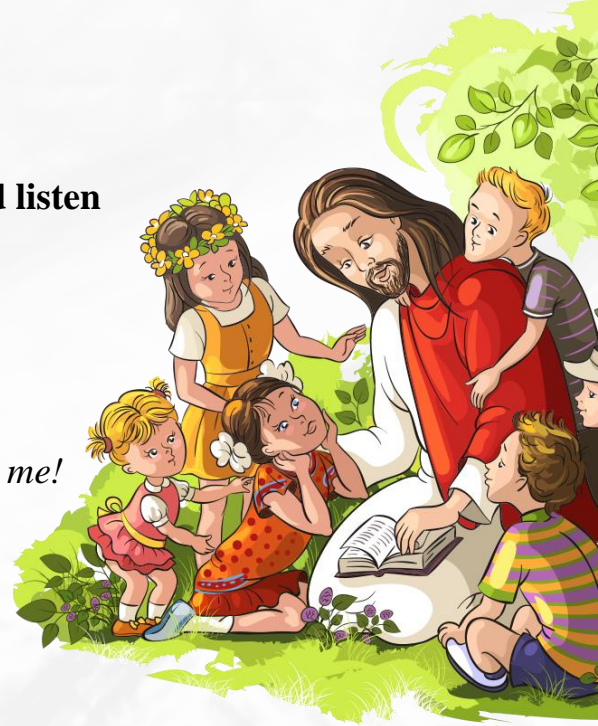
Read them again and listen carefully!

CLOW Gospel Reflection

Reflection: In today's Gospel reading, we hear that Jesus' disciples asked Jesus to teach them how to pray. Prayer is the way that we talk to God, and God wants us to talk to him often. Jesus tells his disciples to pray often, and the prayer that Jesus teaches them is called the Lord's Prayer or the Our Father. It's a prayer that we say during the Mass and it's a prayer that many people say during their own prayer time. God wants us to reach out to him in our need. The good thing about prayer is that we can pray anytime and anywhere. This week, try to think more about the Lord's Prayer, and what the words of the prayer mean to you.
