Reflection: Today we celebrate the twenty-fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel, we hear Jesus tell us the parable of the lost son and forgiving father. A farmer, who had two sons, gave them each some of his money. One son used the money wisely. The other son was careless in his use of the money. Do you remember how the father reacted when his son, who used the money carelessly, returned to him and apologized? The father welcomed him back and celebrated his return with a party. Just like the forgiving father, God is always there for us. God wants to be near to us and celebrates our coming back to him. It's easy for us to lose our way sometimes. But turning our hearts back to God is our daily work.
