CLOW Gospel Reflection

Reflection: In today's Gospel, we hear that the Sadducees – who were a group of religious leaders that did not believe in life after death, questioned Jesus. The Sadducees challenged Jesus to try and trick him. They asked about a woman who had been married seven times. Do you remember what Jesus said to them in response? Jesus told the Sadducees that the rules of earth only go so far and that the Kingdom of God is much bigger than this world. Everything in heaven is different than it is on earth. What do you think this means for us? Could it mean that we are called to do our best here on earth – to love others and care for others? If we all do just a little bit to show God's love, we can help to reflect a little bit of God's Kingdom here on earth.
